

WATERSIDE TOWN HALL MEETING



The Waterside HOA held a town hall meeting on November 3rd at the Bown Library to review a draft of the reserve study, explore an HOA loan and visit with real estate experts in SE Boise. We had 42 members sign-in and we hosted 4 guests: Aaron Lombardo of NorthStar Reserves, April Ahrendsen from the Mutual of Omaha Bank and the Templeton Real Estate Group. Thanks to all who attended and for the positive feedback so far received. The meeting was informational regarding the DRAFT reserve study. A total cost was presented based on current bids and estimates, indicating that there is approximately \$3.2 million of repairs needing to be done IF we did everything next summer. We also explored getting an HOA loan to fund the repairs. Using a loan approach would enable home owners to pay over time and relieve homeowners of large cash assessments. There are limits to qualify for a loan of this size, so a proposal was made to repair the building envelope only at this time. The bids to replace siding, windows, gutters and privacy walls was estimated at \$2.5 million. The current board is committed to keeping the Waterside buildings properly maintained and the grounds safe for the community.



Please keep dogs on leashes when outside your home and pick up waste immediately. Not only is it courteous, it is also in both Boise City code and in the rules and regulations booklet for all of River Run. There are mitt dispensers and garbage cans all along walking paths and along the greenbelt. We have had some neighbors report that dogs have come into their yard off-leash, stayed for a while unsupervised and pooped or killed squirrels. There are many offleash parks and areas that the City provides. Please do not leave dogs unleashed, unsupervised and left to poop at random without clean-up.
